

The States and the Stimulus: Are they using it to create Jobs and a 21st Century Transportation System?

NOTE: Virginia has not filed reporting for all of its proposed spending, therefore only what it has reported to the federal government is included in the report tables. The state's June 17th powerpoint presentation to the Commonwealth Transportation Board (linked below) includes all of the proposed spending of ARRA Surface Transportation Program funds. Only 50% of the statewide spending had to be reported by the 120 deadline.
