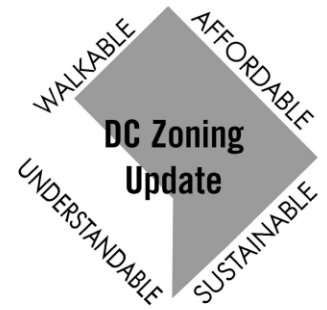


DC Zoning Update Public Outreach



Since 2007, the DC Office of Planning and the DC Zoning Commission have conducted extensive public outreach on the DC zoning update. The process has sought input from ANCs, residents, and other stakeholders. Highlights include:

- Multiple Zoning Commission roundtables in summer 2007
- 81 public work group meetings on 20 topic areas, with a total of 1000 participants
- 42 task force meetings by a representative task force of 25 residents
- 59 public hearings and meetings by the Zoning Commission on specific topics
- 8 meetings in each ward in December 2012 and January 2013 to discuss the zoning revision
- Over 100 ANC, community group, and special interest group meetings with DC Office of Planning
- The full draft proposed text has been available to the Zoning Commission and public since July 29, 2013.

After the full draft proposed text was released, in November 2013, the DC Zoning Commission held **9 well-attended additional public hearings** at One Judiciary Square on a topic-by-topic basis over the course of several evenings.

After the November meetings, the Zoning Commission wanted to hear additional public feedback from residents unable to attend in November. An additional set of four community meetings were then held in areas all over the city in February 2014.
