## **Defining DC's housing needs**

- Extremely low income (ELI) renters: 29%
- Shortage of affordable, available rentals for ELI: -32,990
- ELI household income (4 persons): \$41,400
- 73% ELI renters pay 50%+ income to housing (severe cost burden)
