[Case 25-09](#), Connecticut Avenue NW corridor, Cleveland Park and Woodley Park

- Public hearing date: December 1, 2025
- Why it matters: proposed rezoning would increase substantial development potential within two historic districts with design guidelines that have been pre-approved by Historic Preservation Review Board (HPRB).

[Case 25-13](#), Wisconsin Avenue NW corridor, Friendship Heights to Tenleytown

- Public hearing date: December 11, 2025 (not yet listed on sign up)
- Why it matters: proposed rezoning of Wisconsin Ave. corridor from Friendship Heights to south of Tenleytown would substantially increase housing and redevelopment potential. Rezoning could help encourage increases in housing, including affordable housing, not subject to uncertainties of appeals.
